

1. REGISTRATION

All registration must be completed on the website at IHYC.com. Please see additional instruction at the end of this document. If you need assistance or have any questions please contact Eric Bornebusch at ebihyc@aol.com or 732-581-4718.

2. ORIENTATION

Final Registration and Parent Orientation will be Sunday June 23, 2019

2:00 pm - 3:30 pm - Instructors will conduct a gear check and rigging clinic.

4:00 pm Registration and Orientation. <u>Attendance for a parent or guardian is required</u> to go over last minute details, meet the Instructors and to learn any changes for this season.

5:00 pm Junior Sailing BBQ.

3. DATES AND FORMAT

The regular program will be Monday – Thursday beginning Monday June 24^{TH} and will continue through Thursday, August 15^{TH} . Program will begin at 8:30 am and end at 3:30 pm. Greenies will be 8:00 am – 12:00 pm. Awards will be Friday evening, August 16^{TH} .

This year we are offering optional Friday program for anyone who wishes to attend 5 days a week. Please select this option at time of registration.


The Junior Olympics are held July 22^{nd} & 23^{rd} - there will be no regular program on these days. As this regatta event is hosted by I.H.Y.C, all sailors, except for beginners, are strongly encouraged to register and race. For any kids not participating, they will have off these two days. There will be no sailing program on July 4^{th} . We will have sailing program on Friday July 5^{th} .


River Rookies

July 8-11 & July 15-18 12:00 pm – 3:30 pm River Rookie Ages – Sailor must be 7 or must be going into 2nd grade.

Puddle Ducks

July 29- August 1 & August 5-8 12:00 pm – 3:30pm Puddle Duck Ages – Sailor must be 6 or going into 1st grade





New for 2019! Introduction to sailing

July 1,2,3,5 OR Aug 12-14 12:00 pm - 3:30 pm

A one week introduction to sailing for kids ages 10-16. Introductory seamanship and boat handling will be taught. Anyone wishing to do both weeks will have an ongoing curriculum (not the same course twice).

4. SIZE

The program will be limited to 65 sailors. Due to the individual instruction necessary, the Green Fleet will be limited to 12 per session. Our goal is to maintain a quality program for those children in the program.

5. ELIGIBILITY

All children (except Puddle Ducks and River Rookies as outlined above) must be 8 years old by the start of the program or entering the 3rd grade and not yet 18. (A birth certificate or school report card may be required)

6. PRE-REGISTRATION


There is an online registration process which is extremely important due to the proper hiring and oversight of the program. As indicated on the application, there will be a \$100.00 deposit at time of registration. Please read the pre-registration policy written on the application form to avoid any potential misunderstandings. 
7. REQUIRED PAPERWORK

Available to download on the registration page are the forms for "Statement of Parental Consent and Release from Liability", "Medical Consent", and "Sailor's Code of Conduct". These forms must be properly completed, signed and delivered before your child will be allowed to participate in the Program. Please mail to Eric Bornebusch, P.O. Box 335, Island Heights, NJ 08732

8. BOATS ARE MANDATORY (Except 420 crew, River Rookies, Puddle Ducks, Intro to sailing)

It has been determined that in the bests interests of everyone in the program, all sailors should have a boat to sail from day one. Participation without a boat is unfair to the child, the instructors and to the other sailors. Parents/guardians will have to purchase, lease, rent, or borrow boats in order to fulfill this requirement.





For 2019 we have a limited number of Optimists available for lease at \$200 for the season. These boats are intended for new sailors/families who have not yet decided if they are going to purchase a boat.

9. DIVISIONING

Due to different interests and abilities of each child, the Junior Sailing Committee has decided to separate the program into various distinct divisions. All sailors must pass a basic swim test (no life jacket) on the first day of program.

Beginner or Greenie Fleet (Opti)

The Green fleet will focus on an introduction to sailing. The emphasis is on fundamentals, developing confidence around sailboats, understanding safety on the water and basic seamanship. The BBYRA has updated the guidelines for the Greenie Fleet for 2015 and these may be reviewed at http://www.bbyra.org/greenFleet.htm.

Opti Silver Fleet

Will be for those sailors that have "graduated" from the Green Fleet. This fleet will emphasize participation rather than race results. Fun activities and basic drills will be incorporated into the class in order to foster a true a love sailing as an activity as well as a sport. Participation in Interclub regattas is optional; please speak with your Instructor if you wish your child to participate.

Opti Gold Fleet


This program is designed for the Opti sailor who enjoys some light competition. Participation in Interclub regattas is expected.


Opti Racing Fleet

This program is designed for sailors who truly enjoy competing and who will be racing in all bay area regattas.

Please note - we may adjust the opti program down to 3 fleets instead of 4, depending on the number of sailors.

Sunfish, Laser Radial, & 420 Fleets





These fleets are intended for older, more experienced sailors. Advanced racing techniques and strategies will be focused on as well as the concepts and techniques of double handed sailing. Participation in Interclubs is expected. Participation in all bay area regattas is strongly encouraged.

Travel Laser (Tentative)


This fleet is for experienced sailors who what to take their racing skills further. The program will include Intense, on-the-water coaching interspersed with personal debrief sessions. Classroom lectures, on-the-water drills including tactics, strategy, sail trim, and boat speed. All this in preparation for local and national regattas.


These categories may change based on registration!

The instructional staff will decide, based upon performance levels, which division (with the exception of the Green Fleet) each sailor will participate in. Evaluations of all sailors will continually be done throughout the program to determine if they are capable of moving up a division, if they wish to do so. No child will be forced to move up to any division.

NOTES

- a) If demand exceeds 65, priority will be given to members' children and existing non-member children in the program. Siblings of existing non-members will have priority over new non-members. After May 20th, if there are still spots available, priority will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- b) Pre-registration fees will only be refunded if the spot reserved for your child is filled.
- c) All children registered MUST have their own boat, if not crewing in a 420. Parents/guardians will have to purchase, charter, or rent a boat.
- d) Green fleet sailors must have a bow bumper affixed to their boat at the start of program. The BBYRA has updated the guidelines for the Greenie Fleet for 2015 and these may be reviewed at http://www.bbyra.org/greenFleet.htm.


8 HOW TO REGISTER

Registration is once again on-line this year. After reading this packet, proceed to the calendar appointment for "Jr Sailing Registration" found on Sunday June 23, 2019.

Members log on to your account, proceed to register for yourself. Non-members will need to fill out the information form. Each child will need to be registered individually; there is no way to use contact information from one registration and apply it to another, so you will need to type all required information for each of your children.

<u>STEP 1</u>: On the calendar event, select the "REGISTER HERE" button off to the right.









STEP 2: Select which options is applicable for your sailor.







STEP 4: Review your fees and "Complete Registration"





Once you "Complete Registration", you will arrive on the payment page. At this point, your registration has already been saved.
